- In some cases the most recent national data is from the preceding year



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
## Early years foundation stage profile






### Key messages:

- Except for literacy
- There is a clear gender gap
- There are some very specific educational needs











## Year 1 phonics results



- Our phonics results have improved year on year
- Our phonics results have continued to improve relative to the LA and national
- We have a gender gap
- There are some very specific educational needs







# Key stage 1 results - trends




### Key message:

• Our key stage 1 results remain consistently above national average in all subjects




## Key Stage 1 results - breakdown





- The gender gap is consistent with the LA and national results

## Year 4 results - trends








## Key messages:


- Our year 4 results tend to be broadly in line with the LA for reading
- Our results are more variable for writing and maths


#### Notes:


- School year 4 results can only be compared to LA; there is no equivalent national data available
- There is a new assessment framework for 2015
- It is not known whether the framework is being applied consistently in all schools

## Year 4 results - breakdown












- We have a greater gender gap in literacy than the LA
