Where does the money come from?

The government is provided additional funding of £150 million per annum for academic years 2013 / 2016 to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding was extended in 2016-2017 and increased for 2017-2018. Details of how much we receive and how we use it are on the PE plan and impact report (see below).

This funding is ring-fenced which means it can only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools. Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this.

The school has received this money every year from 2013 onwards. This has been increased 2017-2018.
