The Rotary Club of Dunstable are 'hosting' a Teddy Bear Trail during next week's half-term in order to raise funds for the End Polio Now campaign.

Local shops will be participating by displaying a Teddy Bear in their shops for children to 'find'. This can either be in the window, or inside the shop. Children are expected to be accompanied by an Adult at all times during the 'trail'.

A copy of the 'Treasure Map' can be picked up from the School Reception Foyer or is also available on the school website. Your child will have to find the Teddy Bears and write down the number, which appears on the Teddy Bear, on the 'treasure map'. On the back of the 'map' is an option to participate in a colouring competition. Each child is asked to donate £1 to the End Polio Now campaign. Every £1 donated will be matched by £2 from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation.

One child from each participating group will 'win' a small Teddy Bear – winners will be randomly drawn. These 'winners' will then be entered into a second draw, to win a large Teddy Bear.

There will be three prizes for the colouring teddy bear competition. One winner will be selected from three age categories as follows: 2-4 years, 5-7 years and 8-11 years old.
