26 <sup>th</sup> Feb  World Book Day 1 <sup>st</sup> March	<p><b><u>At Nursery/School</u></b> We will think about all of the people in our Nursery and School that help us and look after us. Letter of the week A for apple for the teacher.</p> <p><b><u>Helping your child's learning</u></b> Encourage older siblings, friends and relations who might be at school to talk to your child about what they do and which adults they know.</p>
5 <sup>th</sup> March	<p><b><u>Nurses and Doctors/Mother's Day</u></b> We will think about all the things that Nurses and Doctors do to look after us and keep us well. Letter of the week N for nurse.</p> <p><b><u>Helping your child's learning</u></b> Talk to your child about times when they have been to see a doctor or nurse and what happened. How did these people help to make them feel better?</p>
12 <sup>th</sup> March	<p><b><u>Fire Service</u></b> We will think about all the things that the Fire Service does to look after us and keep us safe. Letter of the week F for fire.</p> <p><b><u>Helping your child's learning</u></b> Read stories about fire officers and fire engines, perhaps they like 'Fireman Sam'. Can they remember some of the jobs he has done?</p>
19 <sup>th</sup> March	<p><b><u>Police Service</u></b> We will think about all the things that the Police Service does to look after us and keep us safe. Letter of the week P for police.</p> <p><b><u>Helping your child's learning</u></b> Look at pictures of police cars, helicopters and motorcycles and talk about them with your child.</p>
26 <sup>th</sup> March	<p><b><u>Easter</u></b> We will think about Easter as a new beginning and new life. The children will be doing some Easter cooking and Easter crafts. Letter of the week E for eggs.</p> <p><b><u>Helping your child's learning</u></b> Encourage your child to participate in Easter crafts and cooking at home.</p>
