- Write out the recipe in their best handwriting for inclusion in a class recipe book
- Make and bring in the food for the ball on Monday
- Write a label for the food saying the names of the dish and who made it
- Please write whether the dish is vegetarian



Please do not use nuts in any of the recipes

If your child has a special dietary requirement, please label their food clearly e.g. gluten free/ dairy free

We will be designing coats of arms, medieval weaving and of course enjoying a banquet!

Please can your child come to school dressed as a knight, prince, princess, dragon, king or queen- in fact anything that they may have which fits our turrets and tiaras theme.
