Take Home tasks.

Choose **one** of the following:

- Research Tudor Fashion – Make an A4 fashion booklet

As you have had experience of making/seeing dressed models in historical costume you make like to:

- Dress an 'Action man' or 'Barbie' as a Tudor man or lady.
- Research Tudor Recipes – Make an A4 Recipe Book
- Learn a piece of Tudor music/song to present to the class.
- Draw a cartoon strip of a Tudor hunting party. Including staying at a hunting lodge going on a hunt, killing the animals and the hunting lodge banquet.
