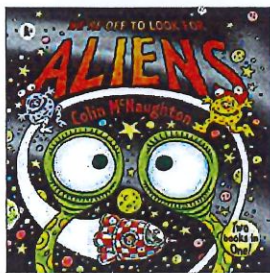




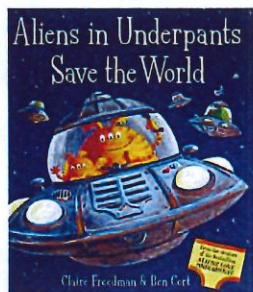
We will continue sending our class bears home with the remaining children so they can share a bedtime story. Please feel free to take a photo and add it to

We will look at these stories.



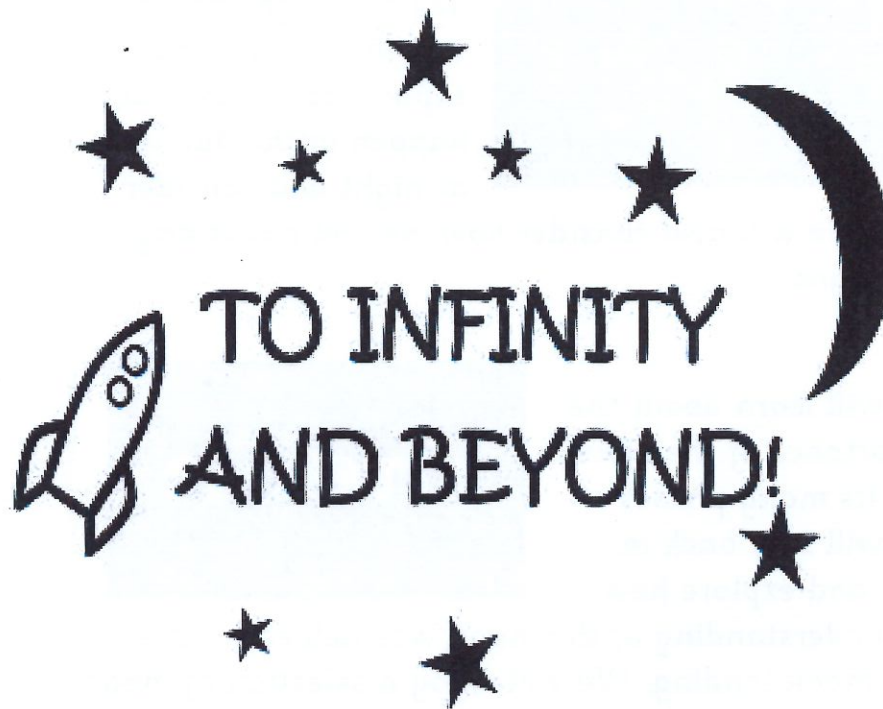

Remember, Remember!

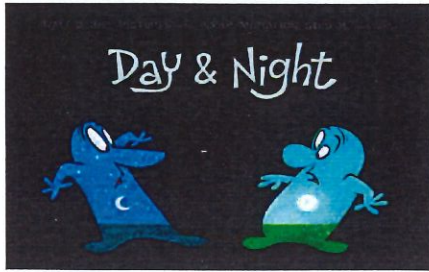
Reading Books are changed on your child's allocated day.

We will learn about the importance of the moon and its many phases. We will step back in time and explore how

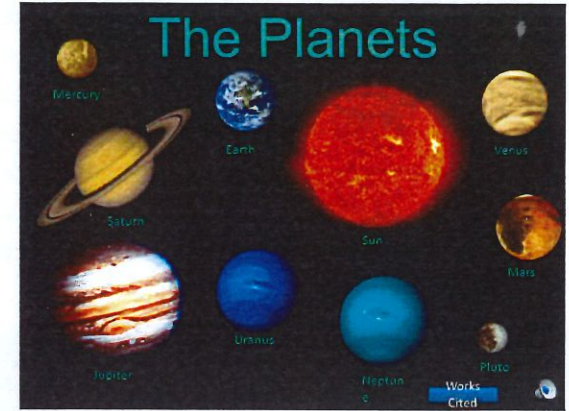


our understanding of the moon was helped by the first moon landing. We will enjoy a selection of moon stories and consider what we might do if we went to the moon. We will even make our own telescopes!
