Good news! Catch up package for schools to help children Children in England are set to benefit from a £1 billion Covid "catch-up" package to directly tackle the impact of lost teaching time this year, the Prime Minister and Education Secretary have confirmed. As plans continue for a full return to education from September, the government has announced £650 million will be shared across state primary and secondary schools over the 2020/21 academic year. Once we have details of how we can use this funding we will begin to plan for how the money is spent, with a focus on small group tuition for whoever needs it. A National Tutoring Programme, worth £350 million, will increase access to high-quality tuition for the most disadvantaged young people over the 2020/21 academic year and we look forward to hearing how our children can benefit from this funding too.

Sports Day Next week there will be lots of information about our 'Real and Virtual Sports Day' on July 3^{rd.} If your child is in school at the moment in the AFTERNOON Ducklings teaching bubble, please send them in the morning session on July 3rd for the school based Sport Days events.
