How do I take part?

In order that the Virtual Big Sing 2020 event follows the Safeguarding guidelines that have put in place, Norfolk Music Hub require each viewer to register using this <u>online form</u>. (Don't worry its quick to do but do it in advance of the day).

The stream itself will be hosted on an unlisted YouTube live video link with all comments being filtered before being displayed. Norfolk Music Hub feel that this, alongside the safety protocol that NYMAZ have adopted, will offer a stable platform enabling all children and young people to take part in the event safely. There is no age restriction for the performance, but we do ask that each child and young person signs up using their parent or guardian's email address as a pre-requisite to taking part.

On the day of the event itself, all participants will be sent the unique event URL via email so that they can enjoy the experience from anywhere in the country on any device.

We will share the Virtual Big Sing resources in school too.
